# HOW TO APPLY

Applications should be made online at www.law. uchicago.edu/lawecon/summerschool.

We ask applicants to provide statements outlining background in law and economics, current research interest, and reasons for interest in attending the Summer School. Applicants must provide a current CV in both English and their working language detailing educational background, employment history, and a list of publications.

**Deadline:** Applications must be submitted online by **January 1, 2013**.

**Notification:** Admission notices will be sent to applicants no later than **January 21, 2013.** 

## COST AND LODGING

Tuition and fees for the Summer School total \$2,500, which includes the cost of lodging, two meals (breakfast and lunch) per day, all organized social activities, and food during class breaks. Participants will be housed at the University of Chicago campus in Hyde Park, Chicago. Participants must arrange for their own travel to and from Chicago.

A refundable deposit of \$500 is required upon acceptance to the Summer School.

The Law School awards a very small number of needbased scholarships to cover tuition and fees. If you believe you may qualify a scholarship, please indicate your interest on the Summer School application form.

Many universities reimburse fees for participation and travel to educational events and conferences. Check with your academic department to see if the Summer School qualifies.
